The Light Vehicle Mechanic is responsible for the verification, inspection, maintenance, and repair of light vehicles and motorized equipment owned by the Nemaska Development Corporation (NDC). The incumbent ensures that all vehicles are in safe and efficient working conditions to meet operational needs. The Mechanic also participates in all activities, including testing, diagnosing, disassembling, replacing parts and assemblies, tuning, adjusting and performing body repairs using common and specialized tools and equipment.

Duties & Responsibilities

- Participate in the development and implementation of preventive maintenance and repair programs for NDC's light vehicles and motorized equipment.
- Perform verification, diagnostics, repairs, and check-ups to ensure vehicles operate safely and efficiently.
- Test, adjust, and tune mechanical and electrical systems using standard and specialized tools, machines, and equipment.
- Replace, repair, or reassemble worn or defective parts and perform adjustments to restore proper function.
- Conduct regular maintenance, including oil and filter changes, brake adjustments, and tire servicing.
- Perform minor body repairs and install accessories such as lights, heaters, and mirrors as required.
- Maintain accurate records of inspections, repairs, and parts used, and report any major mechanical issues to the supervisor.
- Inspect and identify recurring issues or equipment trends and recommend corrective actions or improvements to enhance vehicle reliability.
- Follow established safety procedures and ensure work areas, tools, and equipment are properly maintained.

EMPLOYMENT REQUIREMENTS

- High school diploma with additional training in automotive mechanics
- Appropriate credentials and certification, such as Red Seal or CQP is an asset
- 3 to 5 years of relevant experience as a mechanic
- Fluency in English
- Knowledge of French is an asset
